Complex healthcare needs, multiple long term conditions

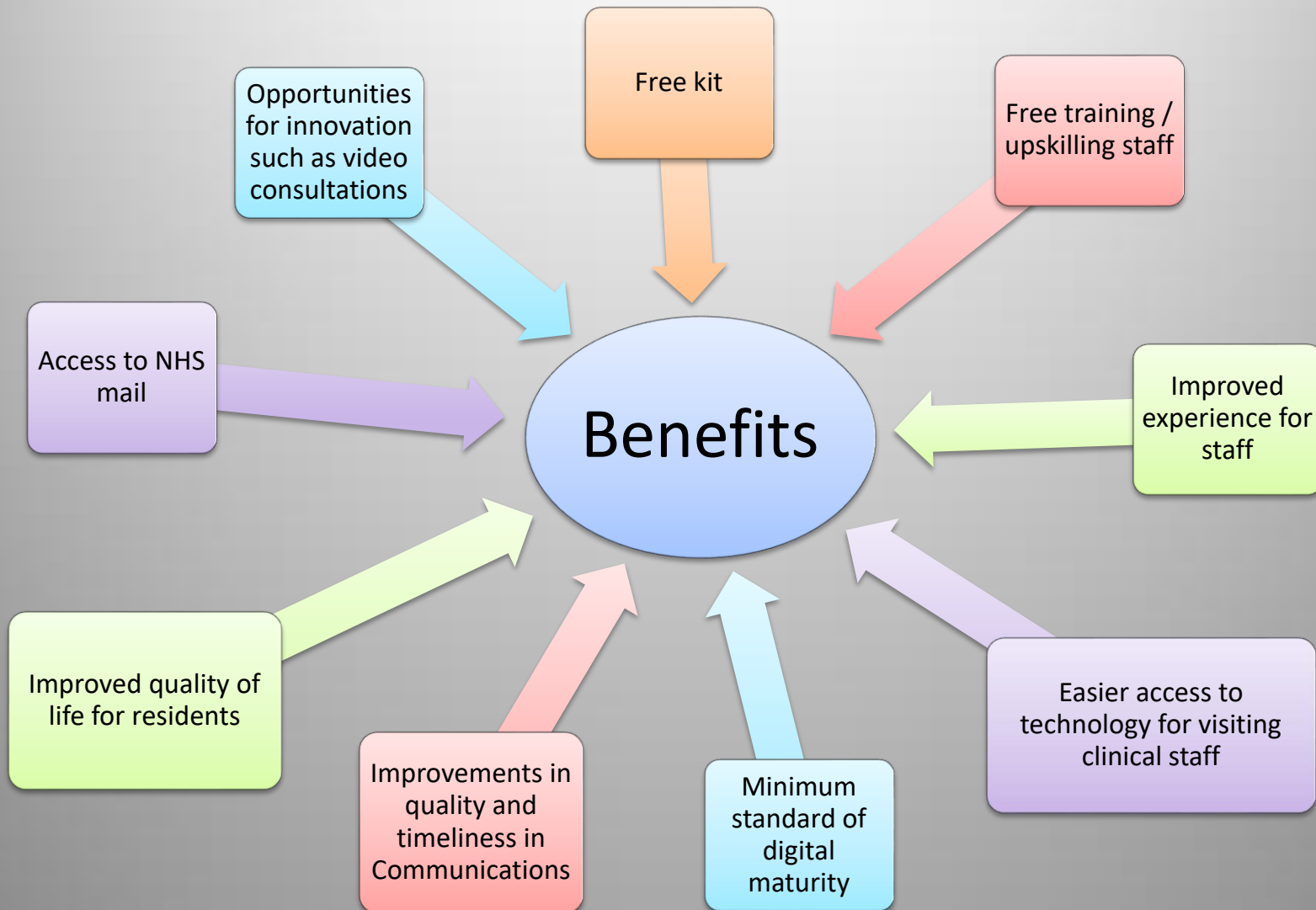
Digital skills within care homes are not always sufficient
